The Elsevier journal Ecosystem Services associated with ESP has done very well in 2013. It has really matured and in total 7 volumes have already been published since the launch in 2012. In 2013, ECOSER published 4 excellent issues, including <u>2 special issues</u>: one on "Mapping and Modelling Payments for Ecosystem Services" and the other on "Payments for Ecosystem Services and their Institutional Dimensions". This GIZ research team is leading the project "ValuES: Methods for integrating ecosystem services into policy, planning, and practice". This project, and this ESP SERVICE-team, aims to bridge the gap felt by practitioners: there is an array of methods, techniques and models to identify, measure and value ecosystem services but there is insufficient know-how regarding the specific application of findings, their impact and integration into policies.
