The registration fee has been fixed now: the early-bird fees (valid until July 1^{st}) are: $275 \in (ESP \text{ members})$, $350 \in (non- ESP \text{ members})$, $200 \in (low-middle income countries, incl. Costa Rica) and <math>150 \in (students)$. After July 1^{st} the fees will be 20% higher (current exchange rate is about $1.35 \ddagger to 1 \in$).
