1. 220+ abstracts currently under review

The official deadline for submission of abstracts for oral presentations has passed. We have received over 220 abstracts, which are currently under review by the session hosts and co-hosts of the +40 sessions. The abstracts will be reviewed on fittingness and quality. If the abstract does not fit in the session of your choice, we will try to fit it into another session if the abstract is of sufficient quality. If you submitted an abstract before May 13, you will receive an email regarding the outcome of the review process between 3 and 7 June, which enables you to use the 'early bird' discount for conference registration if you register before June 15th.
